A. Port FeeGeneral information

Depending on the shipping area and GT of the ship different port fees/charges are charged for the use of the water areas of the Port of Hamburg by the ships listed below. The port fee consists of a GT component, a handling component (tonnes) and an environmental component. The port fees/charges cover a period of up to 120 hours (equivalent to 5 * 24) counted from the time the ship enters the port area up until it leaves the port area.

The notification rules defined in the Port GTC apply. Non-compliance entails penalties as set forth in item D of this Schedule of Fees and Charges.
